

# Comfy Kitten Pullover

- Difficulty Rating:** - Easy
- Size:**
- X-small - 35" chest
  - Small - 39" chest
  - Medium - 43" chest
  - Large - 47" chest
  - Large Plus - 51" chest
- Materials:**
- 11(12,15,17,19) balls of Kitten
  - US #6 knitting needles
- Gauge:**
- In pattern stitch: 6 sts = 1"
- Pattern Stitch:**
- Row1 : Knit, Row2: Purl



**Back:** Cast on 105 (117,129, 141, 153) sts. Work 6 rows of Knit to make 3 garter rows. Work in pattern stitch until piece is 14(14, 15, 15.5, 16) inches. Bind off 7 (9, 11, 12, 14) stitches at the beginning of the next 2 rows. Decrease 1 st each side, every other row 6 (9, 10, 12, 13) X's  
Continue in pattern until piece measures 22 (22.5, 24, 25, 26) inches from start.

**Shape Shoulders:** Bind off 7 (7, 7, 8, 8) stitches at beginning of the next 6 rows. Bind off 37 (39, 43, 45, 49) back of neck stitches.

**Front:** Work as for the back including all shaping.

**And at the same time when piece measures 18.7 (19.2, 20.7, 21.7 22.2) inches**

**Begin Neck Shaping:** Work to center, 13 (13, 15, 15, 17) sts, Attach a second ball of yarn, bind off center 13 (13, 15, 15, 17) stitches, complete row. Bind off 2 stitches at neck edge 3 (3, 3, 3, 4) X's. Dec 1 st at neck edge every other row 6 (7, 8, 9, 8) X's. Continue until piece measures 22 (22.5, 24, 25, 26) inches. Work shoulder shaping to correspond with back.

**Sleeves:** Cast on 56 (62, 64, 66, 70) sts. Work 6 knit rows making 3 garter ridges then work in stockinette.

Begin sleeve shaping: Inc 1 st on each side every row 19 (19, 16, 17, 16) X's, then every 6 row 1 (1, 6, 7, 9) X's. Continue in pattern stitch until piece measures 11(10, 15, 13, 16) inches.

**Cap Shaping:** Bind off 7 (9, 11, 12, 14) stitches each side.

Decrease 1 stitch each side every row 14 (11, 11, 10, 0) X's

Decrease 1 stitch each side every 2nd row 5 (5, 5, 5, 13) X's

Bind off 4 stitches at the beginning of the next 4 (4, 4, 4, 5) rows.

Bind off remaining 16 (18, 18, 20, 20) sts.

**Assembly:** Sew in sleeve and then side seams. Repeat for second side. Weave in all ends.
