

KNITTED

Dad's Lap Wrap

SIZE: Finished size = Approx 60" x 48"
EXPERIENCE: Beginner
MATERIALS: 5 100g balls (205 yards per ball) Fantasy
 10 50g balls (92 yards per ball) Lovely Lash
 U S Size 13, 36" circular knitting needle.
GAUGE: Approx 3 sts = 1".
NOTES: Dad's Lap Wrap is knit from side to side with one strand each of Fantasy and Lovely Lash held together. Measurements are approximate, due to the stretchiness of Garter Stitch.



Dad has knitted this lap wrap in many different color-ways for our shop, Fiber Space in Sterling, Colorado, for over a year now and it is a customer favorite.

LAP WRAP

(worked in Garter Stitch, knit every row, throughout)

Lap Wrap: With 1 strand each of Fantasy and Lovely Lash held together, loosely cast on 150 sts.

Work back and forth on circular needle in Garter Stitch (knit every row) until Wrap measures approx 48" from cast on or until 9 yards of each yarn remains.

Bind off loosely.

Finishing: Work in all tails.

Customize Your Look: Create a new look by using one skein of variegated Lovely Lash at the beginning of the Wrap, eight skeins of a coordinating solid, and finish with the variegated. Start all color changes on a right side row. Make a child's Wrap by casting on 100 sts. A child's version takes seven balls of Lovely Lash and three balls of Fantasy. For larger wraps, 2 balls of Lovely Lash plus 1 ball of Fantasy equals approximately 9 1/2".
