

Eyelash Purse

Difficulty Rating: - Beginner (knit)

Materials:

- 1 ball of Track for each purse. 1 ball of wink.
- 2 feet of ribbon for tie.
- U S Size8 Knitting needles.

Gauge: - 4 stitches = 1 inch

Large purse. Cast on 60 stitches and knit in seed stitch of K1, P1. Every other row P1, K1 to keep seed stitch pattern. Knit for 3 inches. K1, YO, repeat across the row. Knit next row in seed stitch pattern, dropping the YO's. Continue to knit in seed stitch for 6 inches after the YO row. Start decrease for base of purse. Knit 8, Knit 2 TOG, repeat across the row. Knit 1 row. K 7, K 2 TOG, repeat across the row. Knit 1 row. K 6, K 2 TOG, repeat across the row. Knit 1 row. K 5, K 2 TOG, repeat across the row. Knit 1 Row. K 4, K 2 TOG, repeat across the row. Knit 1 row. K 3, K 2 TOG, repeat across the row. Knit one row. K 2, K 2 TOG, repeat across the row. Knit one row. K 1, K 2 TOG, repeat across the row. Knit one row. K 1, K 2 TOG, across the row. Knit one row. K 2 TOG across the row. Cut yarn leaving a 30 inch tail. Thread yarn thru the stitches on the needle and pull tightly. Slip stitch side seams together. This size purse fits over a small oatmeal size box. We glued felt on the box to cover sides and bottom. Thread ribbon thru the holes made by the YO's for the purse tie.



Small purse: Begin Purse with one strand of Track and 2 strands of Wink. Cast on 40 stitches and knit in garter stitch Knit for 6 rows. Drop the Wink and continue on with the Track only for 3 inches from beginning. Knit YO row as above and continue to knit for 5 inches after YO row before starting decrease rows as above. This purse fits nicely over the cardboard that Track is wrapped around Glue a felt circle to bottom to form purse base.
