**"GARTER STITCH SQUARE" BABY BLANKET**

Designed by Dark Horse Design Staff

**SIZE:** Finished size = approx 29" x 29".

**EXPERIENCE:** Beginner

**GAUGE:** 3 sts and 4 rows = 1".

**MATERIALS:** Enchanting (50g balls, 70 yards per ball)  
7 balls Pink and White Multi, Color #122  
U S Size 10 Knitting Needles.

**NOTE:** Gauge is not crucial for the success of this project.

**BLANKET**

(worked in Garter Stitch throughout)

Cast on 1 st. Row 1: K1, yo, k1 = 3 sts.

Row 2: K1, yo, k2 = 4 sts.

Row 3: K1, yo, k to end = 5 sts.

Repeat row 3, having 1 more st each row until piece measures approx 29" along one side edge.

Start Decreases: First row: K1, yo, k2tog, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.

Repeat last row until 5 sts remain

Next row: K1, yo, k2tog, k2tog = 4 sts.

Next row: K1, yo, k3tog = 3 sts.

Next row: K3tog. Fasten off.

**TASSELS (make 4):** Wrap yarn approx 25 times around a 6" piece of cardboard. Before cutting loops on one end of tassel, run a 10" piece of yarn under strands at one end a couple of times. Tie securely, and use the remaining ends of tie for attaching tassel to a corner. Slip tassel off cardboard. Tie another piece of yarn around tassel approx 1" from top, wrap yarn around a couple of times and tie securely. Cut through end loops of tassel. Sew a tassel to each corner, trim ends of tassel.

**KNIT ABBREVIATIONS**

k = knit

st = stitch

sts = stitches

tog = together

yo = yarn over
