

KNITTED MOSS STITCH BABY JACKET

Designed by Dark Horse Design Staff

SIZE: 6 (9, 12) months
Finished chest size 18 (20, 22)".

LEVEL OF EXPERIENCE: Intermediate.

MATERIALS: *Fantasy* (100g ball, 205 yards) by **DARK HORSE YARN, LLC**

2 (2, 3) balls Light Rose #34 or Silver Blue #15
U S Size 8 Knitting Needles
U S Size G Crochet hook.

GAUGE: 5 sts and 5 rows = 1".



JACKET

BACK: Starting at lower edge of back, cast on 47 (51, 55) sts.

Pattern: Row 1: K1, * p1, k1. Repeat from * across.

Rows 2 and 3: P1, * k1, p1. Repeat from * across.

Row 4: K1, *p1, k1. Repeat from * across.

Repeat rows 1 through 4 for pattern until piece measures approx 6 $\frac{3}{4}$ (7 $\frac{1}{2}$, 8)" from beg.

SLEEVES: Cast on 34 (38, 40) sts at beg of each of next 2 rows. Continue in pat on 115 (127, 135) sts until sleeves measure approx 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ (3 $\frac{3}{4}$, 4)". Place a marker at each end of work for one half of sleeve.

SHAPE NECK: Work in pat across 47 (50, 54) sts, place center 21 (27, 27) sts on a holder, join another ball of yarn and work in pat across last 47 (50, 54) sts.

Working both sides at same time, work in pat for 6 (6, 8) rows.

Continuing in pat, cast on 12 (15, 18) sts at neck edge each side. Work even on 59 (65, 72) sts on each side until sleeve measures 7 (7 $\frac{1}{2}$, 8)" from marker.

FRONTS: At each side edge, bind off 34 (38, 40) sts. Continue in pat on 25 (27, 32) sts on each side until fronts measure same length as back below sleeves. Bind off.

HOOD: With right side facing, pick up and knit 18 (19, 20) sts on right front neck, work in pat across 21 (27, 27) sts from holder, pick up and knit 18 (19, 20) sts on left front neck = 57 (65, 67) sts.

Purl 1 row.

BEADING ROW (right side): K2 (1, 1), * yo, k2tog. Repeat from * across, ending with k1 (1, 2).

Purl 1 row.

Work in Moss Stitch pat until hood measures approx 7 (7 $\frac{1}{2}$, 8)" above Beading Row. Bind off.

FINISHING: Fold hood in half and sew across top. Starting at bottom edge, sew side and sleeve seams, reversing last 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " of sleeve for cuff.

CROCHETED EDGING (pink jacket): With RS facing, join yarn with a sc at underarm seam, * skip approx $\frac{1}{4}$ ", work a shell of (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) into same st, sk approx $\frac{1}{4}$ ", sc. Repeat from * around jacket, ending with sl st in beg sc. Fasten off.


CROCHETED EDGING (blue jacket): With RS facing, join yarn with a sc at underarm seam, and working in REVERSE sc, * ch 1, sk 1 st, sc in next st. Repeat from * around jacket, ending with sl st in beg sc. Fasten off.

SLEEVE EDGING: With WS facing, join yarn with a sc at underarm seam and work from * of Crocheted Edging around. Fasten off.

TIE: With 2 strands of yarn, and crochet hook, chain approx 30" long. Fasten off. Work in all ends, thread tie through Beading Row.

beg = beginning
 k = knit
 p = purl
 pat or pats = pattern or patterns
 RS = right side
 st or sts = stitch or stitches
 tog = together
 WS = wrong side

CROCHET ABBREVIATIONS

beg = beginning
 ch = chain
 dc = double crochet
 RS = right side
 sc = single crochet
 sk = skip
 sl st = slip stitch
 st or sts = stitch or stitches
 WS = wrong side
